Terms & Conditions

All Member of Leisure Boat Club (hereinafter called the ("LBC"), agree to follow the following Rules and Regulations:

- 1. All members will attend the prescribed training course for the boat in their programme.
- 2. No person shall be allowed to reserve, use or operate without member on any LBC boat or equipment who:
 - a. Is not a Member, or listed on the boat membership as an operator;
 - b. Is under twenty-one (21) years of age;
 - c. Is intoxicated or impaired as a result of the use of alcohol or any other drug;
 - d. Possesses any illegal drug or substance;
 - e. Is delinquent in LBC dues and charges. Any Member whose payment is delinquent will have ALL boat reservations and use privileges canceled. No further reservations will be accepted by LBC until the account is brought current;
 - f. Is delinquent in all LBC damage charges or other charges;
 - g. Abuses or intentionally damages any boat or equipment;
 - h. Repeatedly violates these rules and regulations.
- 3. LBC reserves the right to cancel boating activities due to inclement weather or other conditions beyond its control. Should inclement weather arise while out on the water, Members shall immediately return to the marina or nearest safe shelter. Members shall also advise LBC of their status.
- 4. Reservations may be scheduled daily by using LBC's online reservation system. Reservations can be made 7 days a week.2-3 reservations are allowed on the schedule at any given time, depending on your Membership Usage Plan. Reservations can be made up to 90 days in advance or as indicated in the terms of your Membership Usage Plan. A minimum of twenty-four (24) hours lead-time is required for scheduled bookings. If a Member will be arriving later than one (1) hour after their scheduled reservation they need to notify LBC to advise. Failure to notify may result in the reservation being canceled and the reservation may be made available to other Members. LBC will be closed for Christmas and New Year's holidays.
- 5. For safety reasons, your cellular phone must be left on at all times.
- 6. Boats must be operated at a wake less speed (no waves behind boat) when entering and traveling around any Marina or area designated as a no wake zone.
- 7. It is recommended that shoes not be worn on boats. If shoes are worn, all care should be given not to step on upholstered seats and black soled shoes are prohibited. Running on docks is prohibited.
- 8. Passengers should not ride on the bow, sides or back of a boat. Passengers must ride inside the boat. Life Jackets should be worn by all children while on board the boat at all times.
- 9. Members shall IMMEDIATELY REPORT any damage that occurs to any LBC boat they are using. In the event of a mechanical or engine failure, Members SHALL NOT attempt to make any repairs themselves. All repairs must be handled by an authorized factory representative. Members shall be liable for all damages caused by their attempts to repair. In the instance an anchor or gas cap is lost, the member will be responsible for replacement charge.
- 10. It is dangerous to circle around a boat engaged in fishing or around swimmers. Boats should stay at least -200 yard -away from a displayed diving flag. (Red flag with white diagonal line).
- 11. Fines and/or imprisonment can be assessed by law against any Member who show disregard for the rights and safety of others so as to endanger persons or property.
- 12. If the Member fails to return any boat or accessory on or before the end of any outing period, that Member will be charged the retail price to replace the item.
- 13. Overboard discarding of plastic containers is prohibited.
- 14. Vessels should be refueled at the end of each boat outing to the level it departed at.
- 15. A boat outing shall be defined as follows:
 - a. Full day 8am to 5pm (Silver & Gold)
 - b. Full day 8am to 6pm (Platinum)
 - c. Weekday: Monday to Friday Except on Public Holidays
 - d. Weekend: Saturay and Sunday, plus Public Holidays
- 16. Members should make every effort to use the designated reservation. If there is a situation where the Member cannot arrive at the designated pick up time they should call the LBC representative in advance.
